ORDER

CORAM: Maya DCJ, Kollapen J, Madlanga J, Majiedt J, Makgoka AJ, Potterill AJ, Rogers J, Theron J and Van Zyl AJ.

The Constitutional Court has considered the application for condonation and the application for leave to appeal and has concluded that, although there are no reasonable prospects of success on the merits of the application for leave to appeal, the delay in bringing the application for leave to appeal is minimal, the explanation for the delay is adequate and there is no prejudice to the respondent. Consequently, condonation is granted, but leave to appeal must be refused for lack of reasonable prospects of success.

Order:

1. Condonation is granted.
2. Leave to appeal is refused with costs.
